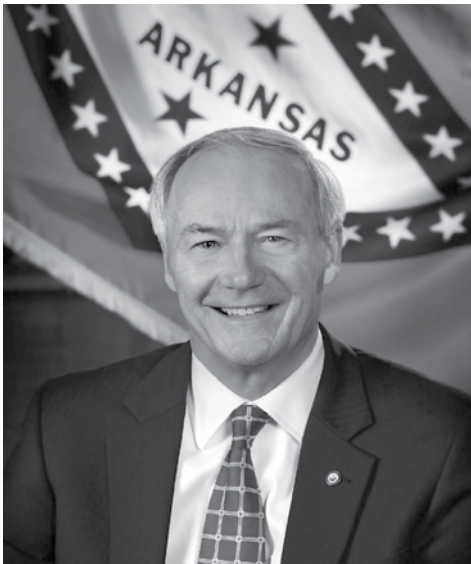

Clinicians



Dr. Terrence E. Donovan

Dr. Terry Donovan received his D.D.S. from the University of Alberta in 1967, and practiced full time in Regina, Saskatchewan for 13 years. He received his Certificate in Advanced Prosthodontics from the University of Southern California in 1981. He was Professor and Director of the Advanced Education in Prosthodontics Program at USC from 1988 - 2006. He has been Associate Dean for General Practice and Executive Associate Dean for Academic Affairs at the University of Southern California, as well as the Chairman of the Department of Restorative Dentistry from 1984 – 1991, and 1994-2001. He is currently Professor and Section Head of Biomaterials in the Department of Operative Dentistry at the University of North Carolina, School of Dentistry at Chapel Hill. He has published extensively, and has lectured world wide on the topics of restorative dentistry and materials science. He is a member of the ADA, CDA, North Carolina Dental Society, CAIC, American Academy of Restorative Dentistry, American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry, the American College of Prosthodontists, a Fellow of the American College of Dentists, and an Honorary Life Member of the College of Dental Surgeons of Saskatchewan, The Association of Prosthodontists of Canada, The Canadian Academy of Restorative Dentistry and Prosthodontics, The American Dental Society of Europe, and the Western Canada Dental Society. He is past Chairman of the American Dental Association's Council on Dental Materials, Instruments, and Equipment..



Dr. Daron Praetzel

Dr. Praetzel is currently the owner of Arkansas Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons, owner of Arkansas Center for Surgical Excellence Surgery Center, and Head of the Facial Trauma team at CHI St. Vincent Medical Center Level II trauma center in Hot Springs. He is a dual board certified Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon and Facial Cosmetic Surgeon, and holds full credential status for facial cosmetic and reconstructive surgery. Dr. Praetzel is currently a Colonel in the United States Air Force Reserves at Little Rock Air Force Base where he serves as the only Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon. He also served 13 years on active duty with the USAF and was deployed to Balad, Iraq for Operation Iraqi Freedom as the Facial Trauma Surgeon. Closer to home, he is the founder of The FACES Foundation – “Fixing those that Help the Community” providing facial corrective surgery for children and adults with facial deformities, and the director and developer of the Hot Springs Study Club with 35 active members (2011 – present). Dr. Praetzel serves as an expert surgical witness for many law firms nationwide. He was born and raised as a twin and one of six children in the city of Erie, Pennsylvania. Dr. Praetzel is married and has three children, and serves as the musical director of Acapella Rising in Little Rock.

The contemporary restorative dentist has an increasing evidence base to consult when making both treatment planning and therapeutic decisions. However, there are numerous areas of controversy where the evidence does not provide a clear answer without interpretation. This presentation will discuss several controversial topics related to restorative dentistry and attempt to provide guidance based on the best available evidence.

Topics to be discussed include:

1. An Evaluation of Current Ceramic Materials
2. Diagnosis and Management of Dental Erosion
3. Current Controversies in Restorative Dentistry
 - a. Amalgam vs. Composite Resin
 - b. Tooth reinforcement with adhesive materials
 - c. Contemporary Cement Selection
 - d. Etiology and Management of Non-carious Cervical Lesions

- e. Bonding of Zirconia Restorations
- f. Direct Pulp Capping: MTA vs. Calcium Hydroxide
- g. Metal vs. Flexible Endodontic Dowels
- h. Implants vs. Endodontics
- i. Cemented vs. Screw-Retained Implant Supported Restorations
- j. Cordless Gingival Displacement
- k. Occlusal Vertical Dimension
- l. Silver diamine fluoride
