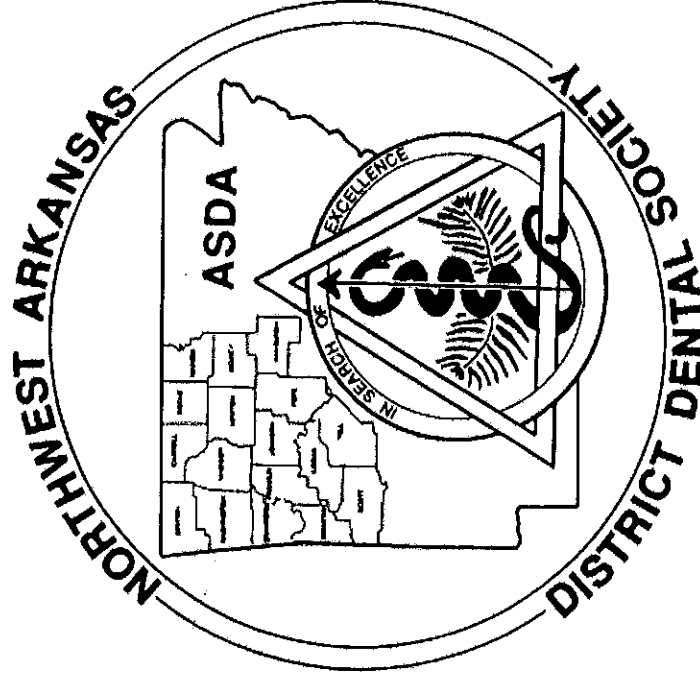

## The Latest Practical Procedures in Implants and Dentures

Dr. Massad is in private practice in Tulsa, OK, he is a Fellow of both the American and the International College of Dentists, a Regent/Fellow of the International Academy for Dental Facial Esthetics, and is any honorary member of the American College of Prosthodontics. Currently, he holds faculty positions at Tufts University School of Dental Medicine in Boston, Mass; the University of Texas Health Science Center Dental School in San Antonio, Texas; the University of Tennessee Health Science Center, College of Dentistry, Memphis, Tenn; Loma Linda University School of Dentistry Loma Linda, CA; and the Univ of Oklahoma School of Dentistry, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. He is the past Director of Removable Prosthodontics at the Scottsdale Center for Dentistry in Arizona, and was an associate faculty member at the L D Pankey Institute in Florida from 1992 to 2005. He is the recipient of the Chicago Mid Winter Gordon Christensen Best Clinician's Award.

He was awarded the most prestigious award for PIONEERS IN DENTISTRY from the American University of Beirut as the third recipient ever bestowed this honor. He has received highest awards in India, China, Germany, Portugal and too many others to mention today.

He served and was president of the Oklahoma Board of Registered Dentists for 7 years and authored the first Ethics policy before his final term ending in 1995. He received the Special Recognition Award while being one of the youngest boards presidents in Oklahoma history. Dr. Massad was a co-recipient of the Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry Best Clinical Article in 2009 for his article the Neutral Zone a guide to Implant Placement. Dr. Joseph Massad has lectured in more than 25 countries and has presented more than 1000 presentations to dental associations around the globe. His upcoming textbook "Applications of the Neutral Zone in Prosthodontics" is shared with Drs. David Cagna, Charles Goodacre, William Wicks and Swati Ahuja with contributing author Mahesh Verma.
