Clinicians



Dr. Hal Crossley

Harold L. Crossley, D.D.S., M.S., Ph.D. is Professor Emeritus at the University of Maryland Dental School. A native of Rhode Island, Dr. Crossley received a Bachelor of Science degree in Pharmacy from the University of Rhode Island in 1964. He later was awarded the Master of Science (1970) and Doctorate degrees (1972) in Pharmacology. The University of Maryland Dental School in Baltimore awarded Dr. Crossley the D.D.S. degree in 1980. The liaison between the classroom and his part-time dental practice produced a practical approach to understanding the pharmacology of drugs used in the dental office.

Dr. Crossley has co-authored a number of articles and four books dealing with a variety of topics within the field of pharmacology. Other areas of expertise include the pharmacology of street drugs and chemical dependency. He was the recipient of the 2008 Gordon Christensen Lecturer Recognition award presented by the Chicago Dental Society and the recipient of the 2012 Award of Distinction presented by the Academy of Dentistry International for his efforts in Continuing Dental Education. He has been a consultant for the United States Drug Enforcement Administration and other law enforcement agencies since 1974. Drawing on this unique background, Dr. Crossley has become nationally and internationally recognized as an expert on street drugs and chemical dependency as well as the clinical pharmacology of dental drugs.



Dr. Fred Church

Dr. Fred Church grew up in Monroe, AL. He attended LSU School of Dentistry and took his periodontal training at University of Texas Health Science Center San Antonio. After practicing traditional periodontics for 34 years he now limits his practice to Stomatology (oral soft tissue diseases). He was appointed to the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners by Gov. Hutchinson in 2015 and will assume the role of President of the Board in September.



Katy Warren RDH

Katy Warren RDH M.Ed is an Associate Professor in the Department of Dental Hygiene at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS). She has her master's degree in adult education and a post-baccalaureate certificate in Public Health. Katy is president of an infection control compliance company, Dental Occupational Consultants, Inc. Katy has made presentations at the local, state, and national level. She is an active member of the American & Arkansas Dental Hygienists' Association (ADHA) and Organization for Safety, Asepsis and Prevention (OSAP).

Opioid Use, Abuse and Addiction: *and* Marijuana; It's Impact on You, Your Family, and Your Dental Practice!

Presenter: **Dr. Hal Crossley**

This program will have two parts. The first half will discuss the addictive nature, abuse, and proper prescribing of opioids in a dental practice. For centuries opioids have been used to control pain and suffering, but at what cost to us, our families, and our dental practices? What are our alternatives for controlling post-operative pain? Are they as effective as opioids? The second half of the day will be devoted to cannabis (marijuana). Thirty-two states (including Arkansas) have legalized marijuana for medical use. Ten states and the District of Columbia have legalized marijuana for recreational purposes. The marijuana of today is not your momma's marijuana and inevitably, some

of these marijuana users will be treated by the dentist or hygienist. Does it have any medicinal use? Is marijuana addicting? What are "shatter", "wax", "dab" or "scat" and how do they differ? The afternoon presentation will discuss some of the concerns about marijuana use/abuse, and its bearing on dental treatment.

- The behavioral aspects of addiction, dependence, and abuse
- Appropriate clinical use of the opioid and non-opioid analgesics
- How to recognize and manage the "doctor shopper"
- The physical characteristics of marijuana
- The evidence supporting medicinal uses
- Differences among edible, vaping, and smoking marijuana
